Sherwood Dog Park opened in 2012 due to the grass roots efforts of a few hard-working individuals and Parks4Pups, along with SLOPOST, the 501(c)3 umbrella organization for SLO County's dog parks. Parks4Pups signed an agreement with the City of Paso Robles to develop and maintain this fenced off-leash dog park on City-owned property in Paso Robles.

Sherwood Dog Park construction was paid for from private donations: no public funds were used to build our park. Our organization is responsible for paying for all park landscaping and maintenance costs and supplies including dog bags, trash can liners, wood chips, plumbing repairs, water, and additional park amenities. **Our annual park maintenance costs are approximately \$6,000 per year.**

We ask park visitors to support our efforts to ensure ongoing maintenance to keep our park beautiful!
